Taputapuātea à votre rencontre

The Culture and Heritage Department of French Polynesia, in partnership with Tahiti Tourisme and the participation of the municipality of Taputapuātea and the Association Na Papa E Va'u, proposed from 20 to 26 April 2015, a patrimonial photographic exhibition called "Tumu-Ra'i-Fēnūa" on the site Te-pō of Ra'iātea. Set up in the framework of the Unesco World Heritage Workshops, that exhibition was the result of three years of missions carried out by the Culture and Heritage Department in order to obtain the "World Heritage" label for Taputapuātea as a cultural landscape. Memory, history, environment, alliances, and portraits: the local communities and the tourists could enjoy some 90 kakemonos and roll-ups illustrating all the aspects of the Taputapuātea Cultural Landscape. That exhibition, which is intended to be a travelling exhibition, will shortly be proposed in digital format on the welcome screens at Tahiti-Fa'a'a airport, and then certainly in other public places such as the Assembly of French Polynesia, the market place of Pape'etē, but also the main town halls of Tahiti and, why not, the Hospital of Ta'aone.
